- **Fundraising Subcommittee**

- **Neurodiversity Subcommittee**

The neurodiversity group are a group of parents with a special interest in neurodiversity. This interest stems from our experiences with our children who may be neuro minorities or from our experiences

of working with neuro diverse people in our professional careers. Neurodiversity is an umbrella term used to advocate for a number of neuro minorities. These include but are not limited to autism, ADHD, dyslexia, dyspraxia, dyscalculia, tourettes, dysgraphia, sensory processing difficulties, language difficulties or social and emotional challenges. Neurodiversity recognises the uniqueness of each human mind. In this group we support each other by sharing our own experiences and knowledge. We also explore ways in which we could use this knowledge to support all the children in our school to be happy, comfortable and engaged throughout their primary school years. We are a new group having met for the first time in October 2022. We plan to meet once a term to continue to share ideas on how we can achieve our aims of raising awareness, knowledge sharing and supporting each other. - **Action on Homework Subcommittee**

FUNDRAISING TARGET 2022/2023

The school has requested fundraising support from the PA to help develop a second hard-court play area at the school. We are hoping to raise €10,000 towards the overall cost (which is around €45,000 for the court, drainage, fencing, and lining) and are planning a series of fundraising activities over the coming months. So far, we have €1,000 from the Hallowe'en Disco (with €1000 already given to the school to support Music Generation 22/23) and the next event is the Table Quiz and Music Night on March 4th.
